

Christi Tims Art –Paint Parties

ARTIST QUALIFICATIONS & EXPERIENCE:

Christi Tims is a professional artist and art teacher. She has university degrees in Visual Art and Education, and several years experience as a classroom fine arts teacher. Christi also teaches paint-night events to adults. Christi runs a small business creating and selling paintings and painted glassware, and does commissioned artwork for clients. Because of Christi's experience as a classroom teacher, she is able to differentiate instruction for all types of learners and personalities.

PRICING:

\$40.00/participant for adults (Participants must be at least 18 years old if alcohol is involved)

\$20.00/participant for children

\$25 for fundraisers (group must qualify as a fundraiser or charity organization.)

There is a minimum charge of \$300.00 to run a party.

INCLUDED:

Instruction for all participants, canvases, paint, brushes, water containers, paint rags, easels and any materials needed to complete the painting project. *

*Projects listed in the main painting choices include all materials. If a custom project is agreed upon between the host and the artist, it may require extra embellishments (Ex. Glitter, beads, etc.) at an extra cost. Custom painting designs are \$50.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE HOST:

-The host must provide a suitable venue. A venue can be a home, rental space, outdoor area, restaurant reservation, etc. as long as it meets the following criteria:

- The venue must have adequate table space to accommodate all participants and easels. (A minimum of 18" wide on the table should be adequate for each participant.)
- The venue must have enough seating for all participants
- The venue must have a sink or bucket area for washing hands and paint-brushes
- The host is responsible for providing/arranging for food and drink. All "sip and paint" parties are BYOB unless the host arranges otherwise. The artist does not provide food or drink at private events.
- The host must provide adequate protection for the area used for painting. (This will differ depending on the venue.) The artist is not responsible for floor drop sheets, or any other items needed to keep the area clean. Remember that painting gets messy and spills happen!

*The host is also responsible to fulfill the cleanup requirements of any venue rented. The artist will help clean up the painting area.

-The host should recommend that the participants wear painting clothes.
Acrylic paints do not wash out of clothing or fabric.

SCHEDULING AND PAYMENT:

When a date is agreed upon between the host and the artist, a deposit of \$50.00 is due. This deposit is refundable -in the event of a cancellation- up to 1 week prior to the event date. 1 week prior to the event, the host must provide the final number of participants in order for the artist to purchase supplies. The host will be charged according to this number as a minimum (additional people may be added with notice and at regular charge) on the date of the party. Final payment is due on the date of the party, and is payable in person VIA cash, credit card, or eTransfer. The \$50.00 deposit will be credited toward the final payment. The artist will provide an invoice/receipt. Individuals may request receipts, but must give the artist notice.
